7 DAYS OF PRAYER

DAY 1: THE OWNER OF THE HOUSE

This House belongs to God. We pattern it after who He is and what He has spoken. As we approach our annual Heart for the House offering, consider the high calling that is on our House, that we would reflect the very heart of God to be unmistakable in our church.

DAY 2: THE FOUNDATION OF THE HOUSE
